The INTERNATIONAL FEDERATION FOR HOME ECONOMICS (IFHE) invites the submission of papers under the Conference theme:

**“Vision 2020: Home Economics Changing Perspectives  
in a Changing Environment”  
Sustainability, Globalisation and Interculturalism**

**CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE OF PAPERS**

1. The first author must be an individual member of IFHE and has to pay the full registration fee for the meeting. A person may submit only **one** paper as **first** author.
2. Papers must be previously unpublished.
3. Papers will be selected on the basis of significant merit and relevance to the Conference theme and to practice.
4. Practitioners' papers should aim at development of integration of theory or integration of the body of knowledge and implementation.

**GUIDELINES**

1. Papers are submitted for either oral or poster presentation:
  - a. **Oral.** The time allowed for oral presentation will be decided by the Committee and will be confirmed in the acceptance letter.
  - b. **Poster.** Authors are to be present with their posters for a specified 6-hour period for discussion. The space allowed for display will be confirmed in the acceptance letter. Audio visual presentations are not suitable substitutes for posters.
2. The Conference Committee will normally assign papers to oral and/or poster presentations as requested, but reserves the right to change category if necessary.
3. Submission of an abstract constitutes a commitment of the author(s), if accepted.
4. Abstracts should be submitted in English in **electronic** form as an e-mail attached file in **WORD and PDF**.
5. **March 1<sup>st</sup> 2010** is the **deadline** for submission to the IFHE Office e-mail [office@ifhe.org](mailto:office@ifhe.org).
6. The final selection of papers will be made by the Conference Committee. Notification of acceptance will be mailed to the first author in March 2010.
